

# YEAR END RAFTING TRIP

## WITH BIG CANYON RAFTING

### OVERVIEW

Big Canyon Rafting has a great school program for ages 9 and up. We receive 100% positive feedback from teachers and kids who take our trips every year! Finish off your school year with a fantastic, positive, accessible outdoor experience with your class!

### TRIP INFO

During our trip, we float down a super fun section of the Quesnel River from Beavermouth to Gravelle Ferry Bridge. There are some great roller waves, float sections, and an exciting splash through the short class 2-3 rapids at Vic and Olli's Canyon. This section is appropriate for students of all abilities, aged 9 and up. No experience required!



Approximately 2 hours on the water, with your whole class rafting together!!

### ITINERARY

- meet at school at regular school time
- drive out on Quesnel Hydraulic Road to Beavermouth Recreation Site\*\*
- put on safety gear
- receive water and raft safety instruction from Trip Leader raft guide
- jump in the rafts with your class
- includes roughly 2 hours on the river
- optional lunch at the end of the trip takes place at river take-out
- drive back to school, arriving at regular dismissal time



*\*\*as per School District 28 policy #810, Big Canyon Rafting is not able to provide transportation for the students unless it is determined that the school district bus fleet is unavailable for use.*

# WHAT TO BRING

- clothing that can get wet, and will dry quickly
- sandals with heel strap or old running shoes that can get wet
- sunglasses (optional)
- waterproof camera to get some great photos of the day (optional)
- warm, dry change of clothes for after the trip



## COST

**\$45/student with no lunch**

**\$50/student with lunch included** (hot dog roast, veggies, fruit, cookies, drink)

\*We invite ONE parent or teacher for every 10 students to join the trip for free. Additional parents or teachers are welcome to join at full price.\*

\*Minimum booking is 20 paying guests\*

## AVAILABILITY

School trips are run on weekdays in June, contact us for available dates.

We raft rain or shine, however, we reserve the right to cancel the trip if we feel conditions are unsafe. If this is necessary, we offer a full refund, or the option to re-book for another date.

Safety is our first priority. However, it is mandatory that all kids and a parent or legal guardian sign a liability release waiver before the trip.
